

2010 ARIAT TULSA REINING CLASSIC CONQUISTADOR WHIZ DERBY CONDITIONS

1. To be held in the September 2-5, 2010 in Tulsa, OK – Tulsa Expo Center.
2. For four, five and six year old horses – Open to all breeds – This is an NRHA approved Category 2 event. All NRHA rules to apply with the following additions.
3. Owner and riders must be current members in good standing of NRHA and horses must have an NRHA competition license. Copies of NRHA Competition License and NRHA membership cards for owner and rider MUST accompany entries.
4. Entries must be received by **Saturday, August 14, 2010** to avoid penalties. Late entries will be accepted and included in the draw until 5:00 pm **Thursday, September 2, 2010** with a \$100 per horse late fee. Late entries will be accepted until 5:00 pm on **Friday, September 3, 2010** with a \$150 per horse late fee, but will be placed in a group preceding the regular draw.
5. The Open Derby and the Non Pro Derby will run separately.
6. The Open Derby and the Non Pro Derby will be decided using one go-round.
7. All Derby entries must enter “up” one class from the lowest division that the person is eligible for. For example, exhibitors must enter the Level 3 division to be able to enter the Level 2 division.
8. Divisions may be added or changed without penalty until 5:00 pm Thursday, September 2. In the event division changes result in differences in entry fee requirements, no refunds will be granted, but any additional fees owed must be paid to compete.
9. Substitutions will be permitted **until 5:00 pm Friday, September 3.**
10. The show retainage for the Derby will be 50%, in addition to the standard 5% NRHA show fee deduction.
11. Prize money will be paid to the owner or designated agent of the horse as indicated on entry form. Appropriate tax information must be on file with OKRHA for payout check to be mailed.
12. All decisions of the judges are final. Three judges will be used for the OKRHA John Deere Derby with all scores being used. A pre check will be utilized.
13. There will be a \$100 judge fee for the Open Derby (all divisions) and a \$75 judge fee for the Non Pro Derby (all divisions). Only one judge’s fee will be required for multiple division entries.
14. Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is ineligible, will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and be subjected to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the *NRHA Handbook*. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the agent or owner.
