

## OKRHA RIDE & SLIDE CONDITIONS

### Derby Conditions

Derby is open to four-, five-, six-, and seven-year-old horses of any breed that have an NRHA competition license.

There are nine divisions of the Tulsa Ride and Slide Derby – Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open (Int. Open), Level 2 Open (Ltd. Open), Level 4 Non-Pro, Level 3 Non-Pro (Int. Non-Pro), Level 2 Non-Pro (Ltd. Non Pro), and Prime Time Non-Pro (50+). The Level 4 Open division is open to any contestant. The Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 4 Non-Pro, Level 3 Non-Pro, Level 2 Non-Pro, eligibility will be based upon the NRHA Category 2 Class eligibility list. Each exhibitor is responsible for his or her correct class eligibility.

A Novice Non-Pro Derby will run concurrently with the Non-Pro Derby. The Novice Non-Pro Derby horse eligibility is \$15,000 in winnings, categories 1, 2 and 6, as of January 1, 2022. The same class entry cut off times stated below for the Non-Pro Derby apply to the Novice Non-Pro Derby. A Novice Open Derby will run concurrently with the Open Derby. The Novice Open Derby horse eligibility is \$15,000 in winnings, categories 1, 2, and 6, as of January 1, 2022. The same class entry cut off times stated below for the Open Derby apply to the Novice Open Derby.

All Derby entries will be required to enter the division above the division they originally enter. (If entering the Level 2 Open Derby you must also enter the Level 3 Open Derby, Level 3 Open must also enter the Level 4 Open. The same rule applies in the Non-Pro Derby, with the exception of the Prime Time as it does not count as an 'enter up'. Entry into the respective Novice Horse Derby will count as an 'enter up' division. The Novice Horse Derbies can be entered alone, ONLY if the exhibitor is already showing 3 horses in the concurrent divisions of said Derby.

Owners and riders must be current members, in good standing, of the NRHA. Copies of NRHA Competition License and NRHA membership cards for owner and rider MUST accompany entries.

The Non-Pro derby entries for the regular draw close at 12 p.m. on Wednesday, March 2, 2022. Entries received after 12 p.m. Wednesday, but before 5 p.m. Thursday, March 3, 2022, will pay a late fee of \$100 and will be FIRST in the class, in the order that late entries are received. No Non-Pro Derby entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. Thursday, March 3, 2022. The regular draw for the Non-Pro Derby will be posted by 9:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 2, 2022. A subsequent draw including all late entries will be posted by 7:00 p.m. Thursday, March 3, 2022.

The Open derby entries for the regular draw close at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 3, 2022. Entries received after 12 p.m. but before 5:00 p.m. Friday, March 4, 2022, will pay a late fee of \$100 and will be FIRST in the class, in the order that late entries are received. No Open Derby entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. Friday, March 4, 2022. The regular draw for the Open Derby will be posted by 5:00 p.m. Thursday, March 3, 2022. A subsequent draw including all late entries will be posted by 7:00 p.m. Friday, March 4, 2022.

Divisions may be added or changed without penalty after the regular cut off but prior 5 pm the day before each Derby class (Non-Pro and Open). If the event division changes result in differences in entry fee requirements, no refunds will be granted, but any additional fees owed must be paid to compete. There will be NO Derby entry refunds after the regular draw closes on each respective draw close day and time.

Both the Non-Pro, Novice Non-Pro, Open and Novice Open Derbies are ONE GO Derbies. Winnings will be calculated according to the NRHA schedule B percentages.

Prize money for all divisions will consist of the respective total entry fees received less NRHA retainage and the trophy fee then, less the 50% show retainage plus the added money in each class.

**2-point Penalty Review:** During the Open and Non-Pro Derby, the judges will be allowed to review 2-point penalties for break of gait, jogging more than two strides and freeze-ups as long as one or more judges has called the 2-point penalty.

### Ancillary Class Conditions

Ancillary class entries close at 12 pm (noon) the day prior to the scheduled class run date. All ancillary class draws will be posted by 5 p.m. the night before the class runs. Entries received after the class closing until 5:00 a.m. the day of the class will go at show managements discretion. There will be a \$50 late fee on late ancillary class entries, excluding Youth classes. Show management will make every effort to post class start times as soon as possible, and announce frequently, estimated class start times, but assumes no responsibility to provide hard start times for each class.

Scratched ancillary entries will be refunded all entry and judges fees if scratched prior to the regular draw close. The office fee will not be refunded. There will be no refunds for ancillary entries after the regular draw close time.

**2-point Penalty Review:** The judges will be allowed to review 2-point penalties for break of gait, jogging more than two strides and freeze-ups as long as one or more judges has called the 2-point penalty.

### GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

**ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.** Three judges will judge the Tulsa Ride and Slide Derbies with all scores being used.

**SCHOOLING:** Exhibitors may be asked to declare intent to school upon entering a class and a time limit in the arena may be imposed. If **SCHOOLING HORSES DURING COMPETITION CONDITIONS**, please remember that every competition class offered at this event is broadcast **LIVE** over the internet to the **WORLD**. In an effort to maintain the integrity and professional appearance of the event, all exhibitors choosing to enter **COMPETITION CLASSES** to school horses, **MUST** present these horses in a professional manner.

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** Traci Davenport Photography will be the official show photographer. Each horse/back number **WILL BE** photographed and **WILL** be assessed a \$10 photo administrative fee, no exceptions. Professional photography is not allowed out of courtesy to our official show photographer. Custom orders and high-resolution photographs are available directly thru Traci.

**VIDEOGRAPHER:** Waltenberry will be the official show videographer. Every run will be videoed and will be assessed the \$20 video fee **PER RUN**. Each exhibitor will receive an email link to their runs. Exhibitors **MUST** sign up at the Waltenberry booth and are encouraged to take advantage of this offer. Custom videos can be ordered as well. Each run **WILL BE** videographed and **WILL BE** assessed a \$20 video fee, no exceptions.

**STALLS:** Move-in will be available no earlier than 12 pm, Saturday, February 26, 2022. Stall reservations encouraged due to first come first served basis. Sponsors of the 2022 Tulsa Ride and Slide will have preferential stall placement. Stall fees are \$170 for the event until **FEBRUARY 12**, after which the fee will be \$200. **ALL HORSES MUST HAVE EITHER A STALL** for the event (\$170) **OR** pay a stall **DAY FEE** (\$85). The only exception is stalls for horses entering **ONLY** Youth or Green Reiner classes the stall fee will be \$100. All other stalls (tack, non-competing horses) are at the published rates. **NO TIE OUTS**. If you want to stall with someone all reservations must be sent together. Show management will try to accommodate requests to split stall assignments at checkout but the person signing for the stalls at check in will be responsible for paying for the number of stalls signed for. Trainer splits need to be in the office by noon Saturday. Shavings are available for purchase on site.

**NSF CHECKS:** All checks returned by the bank as insufficient, **MUST** be replaced with cash, money order or cashier's check, plus a \$100 service charge. Any NSF not cleared up within ten days after notification by the Oklahoma Reining Horse Association will result in immediate suspension from the OKRHA (ineligible for year-end awards or affiliate qualification) and will be assessed an additional \$100 fee. Failure to pay outstanding balance owed after 21 days will result in a report being given to NRHA to begin suspension proceedings. **OKRHA DOES NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS.**

**MEMBERSHIP:** Owner and riders must be current members, in good standing, of the NRHA. Current membership (see NRHA handbook for levels of membership required to compete in certain Entry level or Green Reiner classes) cards or a photocopy must be shown with each entry.

**NRHA COMPETITION LICENSE:** All horses competing in NRHA classes must have an NRHA Competition License, the exception being Green Reiner classes (see NRHA handbook for competition requirements). The original or a photocopy **MUST** be shown with all entries.

**12-month NEGATIVE COGGINS IS REQUIRED.**

**CLOSE OUTS:** Please check out in the show office by noon on Sunday. If you have not closed out by noon, the office staff will begin closing accounts.

**PAYBACKS:** Payback monies will be made according to NRHA payback schedules. Payees must have a completed W-9 on file in order to receive prize money. Winnings for the Derby classes will be paid out at the Event. Derby winnings checks not picked up and/or ancillary winnings checks will not be mailed until a completed W-9 has been provided. Blank W-9's will be available in the show office. It is the Exhibitor/Owner responsibility to provide a completed W-9 in order to receive winnings. If a W-9 has not been provided in the time period allotted by NRHA to mail winnings checks, Internal Revenue Service regulations may be followed regarding withholding on winnings payouts.

**SHOW RETAINAGE:** 50% (Youth classes no show retainage).

**PAID WARMUPS:** Offered first to Tulsa Ride and Slide Sponsors, quantity based on Sponsorship level. Any remaining unreserved paid warmups will be assigned on a first asked basis. Show management reserves the right to limit paid warm up time slots for any reason. No shows for paid warmups that are not resold will be added to the reserving parties show tab, NO EXCEPTIONS. Warmups will be available Sunday, February 27 thru Tuesday, March 1, \$35 for 7 minutes.

**OFFICE FEE:** An office fee of \$30 will be assessed on each horse entered in a class during the event with the exception of horses entered in Youth or Green classes only. If a horse shown in a Youth or Green class is also entered in another class, the office fee will apply.

**MEDICATIONS FEE:** A \$7 NRHA medications fee will be assessed for each horse entered in NRHA approved classes during the event.
