

OKRHA RIDE & SLIDE CONDITIONS

DERBY CONDITIONS

Derby is open to 4-5-6-7 year old horses of any breed that have a NRHA Competition License.

There are 11 divisions of the Tulsa Ride and Slide Derby: Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 4 Non-Pro, Level 3 Non-Pro, Level 2 Non-Pro, and Prime Time Non-Pro (50+). The Level 4 Open division is open to any contestant. The Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 4 Non-Pro, Level 3 Non-Pro, Level 2 Non-Pro, eligibility will be based upon the NRHA Category 2 Class eligibility list. Each exhibitor is responsible for his or her correct class eligibility.

A Novice Non-Pro Derby will run concurrently with the Non-Pro Derby. A Novice Open Derby will run concurrently with the Open Derby. The Novice Derby horse eligibility is \$15,000 in winnings, categories 1, 2, and 6, as of December 31, 2023.

A 4 Yr Old Stakes for the Open and Non Pro will run concurrent with the Open and Non Pro Derby.

The same class entry cut off times stated below for the Open and Non Pro Derbies apply to the Novice Horse and 4 Yr Old divisions.

All Derby entries will be required to enter the division above the division they originally enter. (If entering the Level 2 Open Derby you must also enter the Level 3 Open Derby, Level 3 Open must also enter the Level 4 Open. The same rule applies in the Non-Pro Derby, with the exception of the Prime Time as it does not count as an 'enter up'

Entry into the respective Novice Horse Derby and/or the 4 Yr Old Stakes will not count as an 'enter up', unless the exhibitor is already showing 3 horses in the concurrent divisions of said Derby. (A 4th horse can be entered in the Novice and/or Stakes as a stand alone class/entry) Per NRHA a rider can only ride 3 horses per 'class'

The Open Derby entries for the regular draw close at 12:00 p.m. on SUNDAY, March 3, 2024. Entries received after 12 p.m. but before 5:00 p.m. MONDAY, March 4, 2024, will pay a late fee of \$100 and will be FIRST in the class, in the order that late entries are received. No Open Derby entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. MONDAY. The regular draw for the Open Derby will be posted by 5:00 p.m. SUNDAY. A subsequent draw including all late entries will be posted by 7:00 p.m. MONDAY.

The Non-Pro Derby entries for the regular draw close at 12 p.m. on MONDAY, March 4, 2024. Entries received after 12 p.m. but before 5 p.m. TUESDAY, March 5, 2024, will pay a late fee of \$100 and will be FIRST in the class, in the order that late entries are received. No Non-Pro Derby entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. TUESDAY. The regular draw for the Non-Pro Derby will be posted by 5:00 p.m. MONDAY. A subsequent draw including all late entries will be posted by 7:00 p.m. TUESDAY.

Divisions may be added or changed without penalty after the regular cut off but prior to 5 pm the day before each Derby class (Non-Pro and Open). If the event division changes result in differences in entry fee requirements, no refunds will be granted, but any additional fees owed must be paid to compete. There will be NO Derby entry refunds after the regular draw closes on each respective draw close day and time.

Both the Non-Pro, Novice Non-Pro, 4 Yr Old Non Pro Stakes, Open, Novice Open Derbies and 4 Yr Old Non Open Stakes are ONE GO Derbies. Winnings will be calculated according to the NRHA schedule B percentages.

ANCILLARY CLASS CONDITIONS

Ancillary class entries close at 12 pm (noon) the day prior to the scheduled class run date. All ancillary class draws will be posted by 6 p.m. the night before the class runs. Entries received after the class closing until 5:00 p.m. the day prior to the class will go at show managements discretion. **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER 5PM.** There will be a \$50 late fee on late ancillary class entries, excluding Youth classes. Show management will make every effort to post class start times as soon as possible, and announce frequently, estimated class start times, but assumes no responsibility to provide hard start times for each class.

Scratched ancillary entries will be refunded all entry and judges fees if scratched prior to the regular draw close. The office fee will not be refunded. There will be no refunds for ancillary entries after the regular draw close time.

GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

2-point Penalty Review: The judges will be allowed to review 2-point penalties for break of gait, jogging more than two strides and freeze-ups as long as one or more judges has called the 2-point penalty.

ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL. Five judges will judge the Tulsa Ride and Slide Derbies with the high and low score being dropped.

SCHOOLING: Exhibitors may be asked to declare intent to school upon entering a class and a time limit in the arena may be imposed. If SCHOOLING HORSES DURING COMPETITION CONDITIONS, please remember that every competition class offered at this event is broadcast LIVE over the internet to the WORLD. In an effort to maintain the integrity and professional appearance of the event, all exhibitors choosing to enter COMPETITION CLASSES to school horses, MUST present these horses in a professional manner. You must show with the correct horse/back number as assigned by the show office and on the draw. \$25 fine for having the incorrect number or no number.

PAYBACKS: Payback monies will be made according to NRHA payback schedules. Payees must have a completed W-9 on file in order to receive prize money. Winnings for the Derby classes will be paid out at the Event. Derby winnings checks not picked up and/or ancillary winnings checks will not be mailed until a completed W-9 has been provided. Blank W-9's will be available in the show office. It is the Exhibitor/Owner responsibility to provide a completed W-9 in order to receive winnings. If a W-9 has not been provided in the time period allotted by NRHA to mail winnings checks, Internal Revenue Service regulations may be followed regarding withholding on winnings payouts.

MEMBERSHIP: Owner and riders must be current members, in good standing, of the NRHA. Current membership (see NRHA handbook for levels of membership required to compete in certain Entry level or Green Reiner classes) cards or a photocopy must be shown with each entry.

NRHA COMPETITION LICENSE: All horses competing in NRHA classes must have an NRHA Competition License, the exception being Green Reiner classes (see NRHA handbook). Competition license or a copy must be seen for each horse.

STALLS: Move-in will be available no earlier than 12 pm, Friday, March 1, 2024. Stall reservations are recommended. Sponsors of the 2024 Tulsa Ride and Slide will have preferential stall placement. Stall fees are \$195 for the event with the exception of horses entering ONLY Youth or Green Reiner classes, their stall fee will be \$125. Day stalls will be available for \$95/day. All other stalls (tack, non-competing horses) are at the published rates until FEBRUARY 15, after which all stalls will be assessed an additional \$30 late fee. Any stall cancellations after February 25th will be refunded all but \$25. **ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A STALL! NO TIE OUTS.**

If you want to stall with someone all reservations must be sent together. Show management will try to accommodate requests to split stall assignments at check in/out but the person signing for the stalls at check in will be responsible for paying for the number of stalls signed for. Any Trainer splits need to be in the office by noon Saturday. Shavings are available for purchase at Fairgrounds Feed & Bedding orders@fairgroundsfeedandbedding.com or call (918) 376-6016.

PAID WARMUPS: Offered first to Tulsa Ride and Slide Sponsors, quantity based on Sponsorship level. Any remaining unreserved paid warmups will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Show management reserves the right to limit paid warm up time slots for any reason. No-shows for paid warmups that are not resold will be added to the reserving parties show tab, NO EXCEPTIONS. Warmups will be available Saturday March 2- Monday March 4, they are \$40 for 7 minutes.

12-Month NEGATIVE Coggins is REQUIRED

CLOSE OUTS: You can close out in the show office at anytime you are done showing. If you have not checked out by 4PM on Saturday, the office staff will begin closing accounts.

Additional Fees:

VIDEOGRAPHER: Equine Promotions will be the "Official Videographer" Every run will be videoed and will be assessed a \$20 video fee PER RUN. Each exhibitor will receive an email link to their runs. Exhibitors MUST sign up at the video booth and are encouraged to take advantage of this offer. Custom videos can be ordered as well.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Traci Davenport Photography will be the "Official Show Photographer". Each horse/back number WILL BE photographed and WILL be assessed a \$10 photo administrative fee, no exceptions.

Professional photography is not allowed out of courtesy to our official show photographer. Custom orders and high-resolution photographs are available directly thru Traci.

OFFICE FEE: An office fee of \$30 will be assessed on each horse entered in a class during the event with the exception of horses entered in ONLY Youth or Green classes

MEDICATIONS FEE: A \$35 NRHA medications fee will be assessed for each horse entered in NRHA approved classes during the event.

A 5% convenience fee will be added to any fees being paid with a Credit/Debit card.
